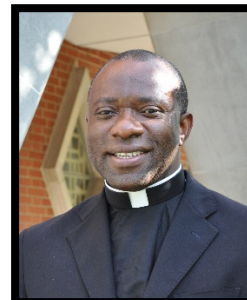
## Well Done Fr. Michael Udoekpo!
