This week an "altarcito" will be prepared in Sacred Heart Chapel entrance. Please feel free to bring photos of deceased relatives and friends and place them on the "altarcito." As we begin the month of November with our liturgical celebrations of the Solemnity of All Saints and the Commemoration of the Faithful Departed, we will be reminded of our communion with those who have gone before us in faith and of our hope of resurrection.

Admission of Candidacy to Holy Orders


