It is with great honor to announce the recent publication of two articles produced by Fr. Vien Nguyen, SCJ and Dcn. Steve Kramer.

Fr. Vien's article has appeared in two peer-reviewed journals (distributed by the same publisher) – one in print (Journal of Biblical Theology) and one online (American Journal of Biblical Theology).

In this article, Fr. Vien argues that a narrative analysis of the two conversion stories in Acts 8:5-40 reveals that "the Ethiopian eunuch is portrayed as being liberated from his spiritual marginal status, whereas Simon the Great still struggles to liberate himself from his magical worldview and practices." 

## In Memory of Reverend Richard Joseph Schlenker – Sacred Heart Faculty from 1988-1999

On Tuesday, November 5, 2019, Reverend Richard Joseph Schlenker passed away at the age of 88. He was ordained to the priesthood by Most Albert G. Meyer, Archbishop of Milwaukee, on May 26, 1956, at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist, Milwaukee. On July 1, 1988, he was appointed to Sacred Heart; he retired from active ministry on March 31,

1999.

A concelebrated Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30am on Saturday, November 9, 2019, at the Clement Manor Chapel in Greenfield (3939 South 92nd Street). Per Fr. Schlenker's wishes, there will not be visitation prior to the funeral Mass.
