Therefore, we are suspending classes on campus for the upcoming week. Professors will email assignments to their students to complete until they can arrange to do courses on-line via Populi. We envisage this taking place until Easter Break. Class objectives will be adjusted so that we can attempt to finish the semester on 1 May as planned.

In-house seminarians are strongly encouraged to stay here at Sacred Heart during this time and to avoid travel or going out (especially across state lines) in order to practice “social distancing” (self-quarantining) and possibly not being exposed to the virus.
