
Sacred Heart is happy to announce the publication of an article by Deacon Steve Kramer that has appeared in the May issue of The Deacon.

We cannot assume that everyone will understand the concept of biblical covenant. If our language is modified so that it resonates with people, they will be able to follow our ideas and adopt them."
