In the spirit of good communication and to update you on our response to the current pandemic developments, I want to inform you that the President's Council met to discuss our next steps as we anticipate the lifting of the safer-at-home restrictions. We know that these are anxious times. Be assured that the safety of all of us is our top priority. We are thus working on developing measures to protect the safety, welfare, and good health of our staff, residents, students, and visitors to the building following the guidance of local health officials. A subcommittee of the President's Council comprised of Chris Lambert, Chris McAtee, and Patrick Russell is developing a plan to gradually reopen campus. This plan will be communicated to everyone once fully developed.

As part of the discussion, the President's Council also considered three main options for resuming on-campus courses in the fall semester and moving forward beyond that. These and our plan for reopening campus are being forward to the Executive Committee of the Board of Directors who will meet on 20 May. They will discuss these and other options the members of the committee might identify in preparation for the full Board of Directors meeting scheduled for 27 May.

I will continue to update you as information becomes available. In the meantime, thank you for your patience and cooperation.
