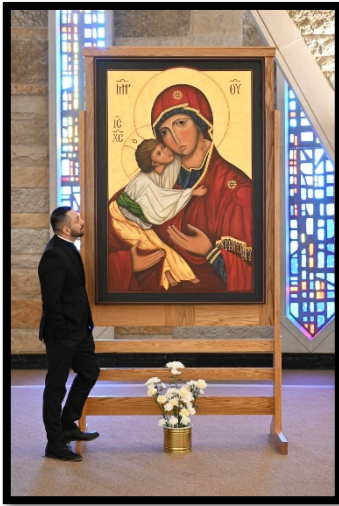

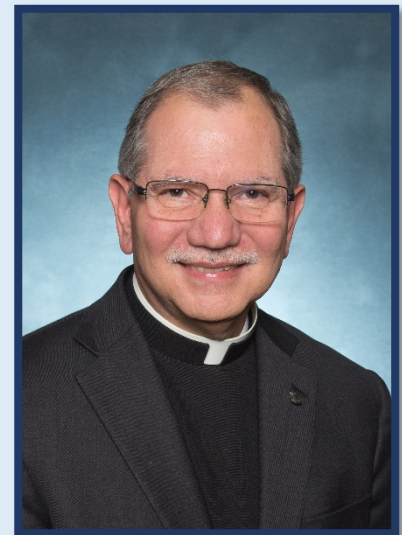

Imperatori-Lee deserves congratulations for breaking new ecclesiological ground and encouragement to move forward with this work.”

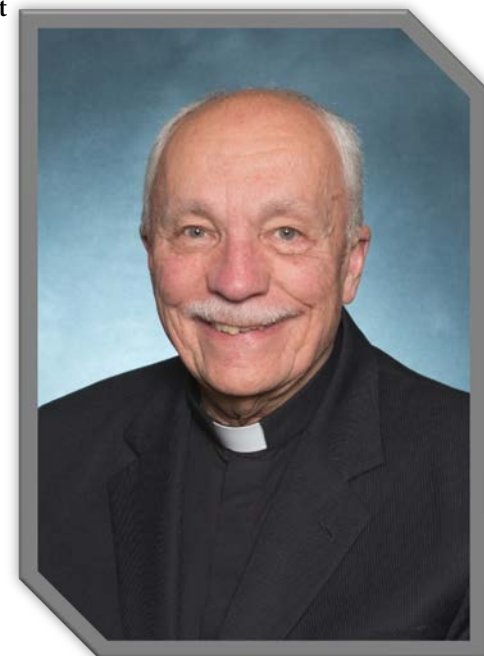

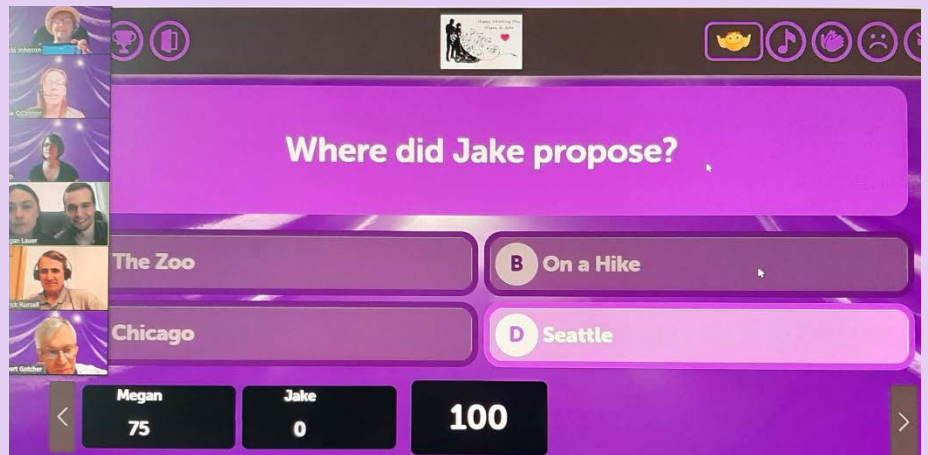
