Program Cost (Fall 2020)

The \$20,460 (33 credits x \$620 per credit hour) tuition was reduced to \$8,000 for the fall 2020 cohort!

Sacred Heart made this decision in support of our vision to “Conform our World to the Heart of Christ”. Due to that reduction, there are no other scholarships available through the school. Fees and are additional.
