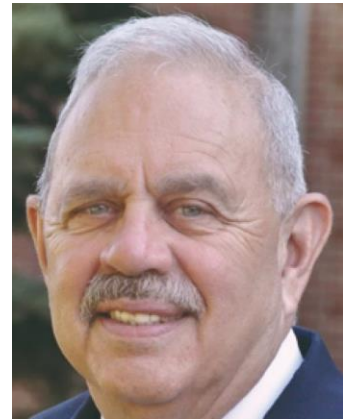
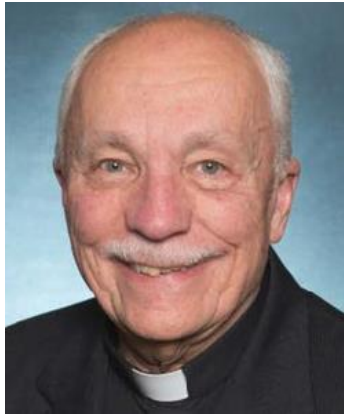

## Not a Goodbye, but a See You Later...

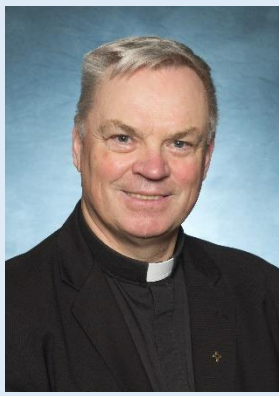

Dr. Stroud writes, "For those doing study in the field of environmental or human ecology, *Just Water* serves as an indispensable resource for understanding the fresh water issue through the lens of the Catholic social tradition, especially as a right-to-life issue (chapter 4). In presenting fresh water as such an issue, Zenner helpfully focuses on claims drawn from Catholic social teaching to illuminate the place of fresh water as an important issue for all of humanity."

### Dcn. Kramer's article publication information:

In his article, Dcn. Kramer explains the importance of preaching with reverence. He writes, "Jesus was born into a Jewish family and lived according to the Law. His ministry of preaching, teaching and healing was enfolded into the traditions of his people. Often he quoted the prophets and the importance of returning to the promises of the covenant that God had made with the Jewish people. When E.F. Hutton spoke, people listened. When the prophets and Jesus spoke, people listened (Ez 33:7). Prepare your message well, brothers, so that the people will listen."
