Lux Center News

On the evening of Friday, September 18, the observance of the Jewish New Year, Rosh Hashanah begins. It officially starts at sundown and ends at sundown on Saturday, September 19.

This begins the year 5781 on the Jewish calendar. Rosh Hashanah (literal translation from the Hebrew is "the head of the year") begins the Jewish High Holy Days, the holiest days of the Jewish year. It is a time of deep introspection and self-examination, a time to take stock of one's actions during the past year, and a time to ask forgiveness from others and from God. The ten days following Rosh Hashanah are known as the Days of Awe and then comes Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement.

Congratulations to Jon Sweeney, a member of the Lux Center's Governing Board, who released a review of the book *Jesus Wasn't Killed by the Jews*. When: Wednesday, October 14th

Time: 11:30 am to 1:30 pm (no 11:00am mass that day)

Location: SHSST Lobby

Walgreens will bring authorization forms to sign.
They will accept all insurance cards as well as Medicare.

The regular flu shot and the high-dose flu shot (recommended for those 65+) will be available to you at our annual Flu Clinic. Pneumonia vaccines will be available as well, if needed.

Preventive care vaccines are offered at no cost to employees participating in SHSST's group health insurance plan. If you are not a participating member of SHSST's medical plan, please review your policy's coverage. If a copay is required, please bring payment. Normally family members are welcome; however, this year because of the public health crisis, we ask that they obtain their flu vaccine through other means.

Fr. Ed Zemlik is coordinating payment on behalf of the SCJ residents/monastery community and the SCJ-Sponsored ECS Students. If you fall into one of these categories, **please sign up no later than October 12th**. The Sign-Up Sheet is located on the bulletin board across from St. Joseph's Chapel (adjacent to HR Room 214). SHSST Employees are not required to sign-up.

If you don't have insurance and choose to pay cash, the cost will be:

<u>Flu Vaccines</u>	
Influenza/Flu (Fluarix)	\$ 40.99
High-Dose (Fluzone HD) (65+)	\$ 72.99

You will be required to complete a VAR – Vaccine Administration Record. It is attached to the email invitation. Please print it and complete it before coming to the flu clinic, along with your identification (D.L.) and insurance card. If you are waiting in line, please be cognizant of 6' social distancing and keep your mask on at all times.
