Fall 2021 Cohort Tuition Information

Provided below are the tuition and fees for the two years in which you will be in the program (Fall semester 2021 through May-June session 2023). Please note, this is reduced from the previous amount of \$20,460. Accepted applicants will be asked to submit a \$250 deposit to secure their seat, within 30 days of acceptance.

There is also a technology fee of \$150 in the fall and spring semesters (not the May semesters), and a graduation fee of \$150 charged in the final May semester.

*During the May/Summer 2021 session, students have three study options. If you select the Archaeological Expedition to the Holy Land as one of these three options, there will be additional expenses related to travel and lodging in addition to the tuition amount listed above.

You will receive an invoice from the Finance Office for the amount due for each semester. Payments are to be made to the Finance Office in U.S. dollars and can be submitted by check or Mastercard/VISA. See the School Catalog for more information.

If you are able to contribute beyond the \$8,500, please consider making a donation to the school.

Students in the *Cor Unum* program are eligible for federal unsubsidized student loans. Federal student loans can be used to defray any direct (e.g., tuition, fees, books) or indirect (e.g., living expenses) costs associated with your graduate studies.
