## Feast of the Presentation of the Lord

February 2nd was the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. Father José González, Director of SHSST's Hispanic Ministry Preparation Program, presided. Traditionally this day marked the last day of Christmas. The feast is also known as Candlemas because candles are blessed and lit as part of the entrance procession. February 2nd is also the World Day of Consecrated Life when prayers are offered for men and women religious. In some countries the images of the baby Jesus are lifted from the crib and brought to Mass for a blessing before they are put away until the next Christmas Eve and placed in the manger.

#### National Catholic Schools Week






