As many of Wisconsin's COVID-19 vaccine providers are directing patients online to schedule appointments, some residents might be feeling left behind.

While most major health systems have asked those eligible for a vaccine not to call their doctor's offices and hospitals — and instead wait to hear from them — some vaccine providers have set up vaccine information and registration hotlines for those who might not have an internet connection, a smartphone or an email address.

Below is a list of phone numbers, email addresses, links and directions on how to register for a vaccination appointment at Milwaukee-area health departments and health systems.

### Milwaukee County

Milwaukee County's website, HealthyMKE .com, allows residents to sign up for vaccine updates as well as get connected with a vaccine provider.

Schedule an appointment at milwaukee.gov /covidvax. You need both an email address and phone number to register online. If you do not have both an email and a phone number, call either the vaccine hotline at (414) 286-6800 or 211 to register. You can also

### Aurora Health Care

Download the Live Well app. Aurora will send a special code and instructions on how to schedule your appointment when you are eligible.

Aurora asks people not to call their doctor's offices and clinics. Staff will contact patients when they can schedule an appointment.

When Aurora contacts you, they will provide a number to call if you want to schedule the appointment over the phone.

### Froedtert Health

It will contact patients by email, letter or through the MyChart feature of its electronic health records system to schedule vaccine appointments.
