### **Program Cost (Fall 2022 Cohort)**

The \$20,460 (33 credits x \$620 per credit hour) tuition was reduced to \$9,500 for the fall 2022 cohort! Sacred Heart made this decision in support of our vision to “Conform our World to the Heart of Christ.” Fees and books are additional.
