 - Bakashot, Hoda'ot, Shevach (Anne Lamont)*
- Determined by time, place, events, etc.
- We develop and share fixed prayers for everything:
 - Daily prayers: upon waking, eating food (several), using the restroom, learning
 - Special occasion: something joyful, lifecycle events, seeing a rainbow, meeting a head of state
 - Times of strife: healing (mi shebeirach, psalms), going on a long journey, surviving a danger,
