YOUR SEMINARY: Specialized formation for a universal Church

Lumen Cordis

Students in the SHSST Lumen Cordis pathway select an area of concentration, each with many opportunities for electives fitting the student's particular goals and interests.

- Scripture: Focused on a critical and careful study of Sacred Scripture.
- **Systematic Theology:** Focused on a comprehensive examination of the Christian faith.

Regardless of the area of concentration, students have two routes to graduation:

- Plan A, which requires 33 graduate credit hours of course work, and
- Plan B, which requires 27 graduate credit hours of course work plus a six-credit thesis.

Lumen Cordis Requirements

All students complete three of the following:

- Scriptural Foundations (three credits)
- Fundamental Theology (three credits)
- Foundations of Christian Spirituality (three credits)
- Fundamental Moral Theology (three credits)

Plan A students also complete:

- 15 credits in the chosen area of concentration
- Nine elective credits
- Comprehensive exams (oral and written)

Plan B students also complete:

- 15 credits in the chosen area of concentration
- Three elective credits
- M.A. thesis (six credits)
- Language requirement
