DT--612 Theology of Grace

God, infinitely perfect and blessed in himself, in a plan of sheer goodness freely created man to make him share in his own blessed life" (CCC 1). This course seeks to understand the gift, even the "rest", entailed when God calls you "friend" and "son" or "daughter". By examining this personal relationship between the Triune God and his image in the human being, this course aims at an articulation of the mystery of grace in its necessity, its essence, its divisions, its cause and its effects (cf *ST I-II*, qq.109-14). Through an account and analysis of the history and theology of grace, we hope to know better the source, the means, and the mystery of God's life, our share in it, and the gift that makes it possible.
