Lux Center Spring Public and Sacred Heart Community Lectures On Sunday, March 26, Sacred Heart held the Spring Lux Center Public Lecture. About 80 people attended from the public. Dr. Malka Z. Simkovich presented on the topic, "Jewish Sects in the New Testament". Dr. Malka Z. Simkovich is the Crown-Ryan Chair of Jewish Studies and the director of the Catholic-Jewish Studies program at Catholic Theological Union in Chicago.

Additionally, on Monday, March 27, Dr. Malka Z. Simkovich presented at the Spring 2023 Lux Center Lecture for the Sacred Heart Community. The lecture titled, "What did Judea-Diaspora Relations Look Like in the Hellenistic World", was given to faculty, staff, and student body.
