Program Tuition (Fall 2024 Cohort)

The \$20,460 (33 credits x \$620 per credit hour) tuition was reduced to \$9,500 for the Fall 2024 cohort! Sacred Heart made this decision in support of our vision to "Conform our World to the Heart of Christ." Note that technology and graduation fees (\$150 each) are reflected in the totals below. Book costs are additional.
