

Day of Recollection

Sacred Heart had a Day of Recollection on April 8. Most Rev. David L. Ricken, the bishop of the Diocese of Green Bay, led the morning and afternoon reflections focusing his talks on the topic of "Eucharist and Priestly Identity". Sacred Music in the Seminary

On April 4, Dr. Benjamin Stone, Director of Liturgy & Music and Lecturer of Pastoral Studies, performed a recital of music for the Easter season, including works by Johann Sebastian Bach, Heinrich Scheidemann, Johann Ludwig Krebs, and Christa Rakich. Dr. Stone also presented a talk on the evening's musical selections before the recital. The performance was featured on the beautiful Berghaus organ, installed 30 years ago and meticulously restored in 2021. Dr. Stone holds both a Doctor of Musical Arts and a Master of Sacred Music from the University of Notre Dame.





Total Solar Eclipse

On April 8, Sacred Heart faculty and staff headed outside to view the solar eclipse with eclipse glasses and pinhole viewing cards made by Ms. Kathy Harty.

A total solar eclipse occurs when the Moon's apparent diameter is larger than the Sun's, blocking all direct sunlight, and turning day into darkness. Totality occurs only in a narrow path across the Earth's surface, with the partial solar eclipse visible over a surrounding region thousands of kilometers wide (Daily Express).
