

Seminarians enter formation in the Propaedeutic Stage.
This stage lays the foundation of the formational journey, emphasizing human and spiritual development.
Men live in a community of discernment and accompaniment, apart from the seminary, for 12 months to two years.

Retreat & Formation at Dehon House

Participants start the discernment year in late summer with a retreat and orientation to the propaedeutic stage, living and praying at our Dehon House, *under the direction of priest formator* Fr. Zbigniew "Ziggy" Morawiec, SCJ, STL.

During the fall & spring semesters, the men continue their discernment, building a foundation emphasizing the human and spiritual dimensions of priestly formation. They have a daily horarium of communal liturgy, service, study, and formation sessions.

Intentional learning excursions to Catholic sites will enrich the course content. The above classes fulfill requirements for loan deferrals and student visas.

The Dehon House, located on the campus of Sacred Heart Seminary and School of Theology, is a beautifully renovated five-bedroom home that serves as the communal living space for the Propaedeutic Stage. With two chapels, it provides an ideal space for discerners to grow in prayer, including "scriptural meditation and the art of lectio divina" that are essential to this stage in formation (PPF no. 123).
