There were fifteen men from around the state of Maine who participated. This was their first exposure to the art of preaching. We covered prayer, preparation, exegesis, and audience familiarity. A bibliography was given to the candidates to prepare them for future coursework and practicum in preaching. (April 12, 2025)
- Lenten Retreat: I gave the Holy Name Society Annual Men's Lenten Retreat for St. Matthew Parish in Oak Creek, Wisconsin. There were 40 men in attendance. The title was "Hope Is Vital in a Man's Relationship With God and Others." (April 5, 2025).

 had to videotape a homily/reflection in a parish audience complete with congregation
 feedback. Candidates were then assessed by their peers and myself.
- SHSST Alumni Gathering: Met with three SHSST priest alumni of the Diocese of Davenport, Iowa. This was held while I was in Davenport giving the retreat for Deacons & Wives of the diocese. We met for several hours concerning their time at SHSST and how we can better market the seminary. (April 20, 2024).

- Annual Retreat for Deacons, Wives, and Aspirants: I gave the annual retreat for Deacons, Wives, and Aspirants of the Diocese of Davenport, Iowa. The theme of the retreat was "Diaconal Spirituality and The Word of God." There were 45 attendees at the conference. I gave a series of five talks which intertwined spirituality, family, and, ministry. The event was held at the Holy Trinity Retreat Center in Riverside, Iowa. (April 19-21, 2024).
- **Diaconal Preaching Placement:** advising for deacons at St. Francis de Sales Seminary who have been assigned to Milwaukee teaching parishes. Working with Fr. Glenn Powers and meeting with the Saint Francis deacons in order that they will meet the requirements to satisfy their pastoral studies obligations at Saint Francis.

- **Plenary Convocation Presentation:** I presented a one hour talk to over 300 members of the diaconate community at the Diocese of Joliet's Diaconate Plenary Convocation. The talk was entitled, "Preaching with Mary, Mother of the Diaconate". I was one of four

- presenters for the weekend event. The gathering was held at the Hyatt Lodge in Oak Brook, Illinois. (October 27, 2024).

 and writing assignments, each candidate preached four Sunday homilies, one funeral
 and one baptism homily.
