

Sacred Heart Pilgrimage

The SHSST pilgrimage group had a marvelous experience retracing the footsteps of St. Paul through Greece and western Turkey. In Greece, they walked in Corinth, Athens, Thessalonica, and Philippi. When they arrived in Turkey, they expanded their focus to the sites of the first seven ecumenical Church councils -Hagia Sophia and Hagia Irene in Constantinople, Chalcedon, and, as mentioned in the greeting, Nicaea. Visiting this latter site of the first council, which happened in 325 AD, during the exact same dates as the council fathers met 1700 years ago was particularly moving! Along the way they prayed together and celebrated daily masses in majestic cathedrals and humble rooms -- with their experience of joining the local community on Ascension Sunday at Saint Esprit Cathedral being a particular highlight.
